	Competence, Abstract and Relate question on separate sticky notes. COMPETENCE Question answers can be found in the text or
	pictures of the book.ABSTRACT Questions require students to make inferences or predictions.
	RELATE Questions connect students' experiences to the book.
	Place the sticky note with the question on the corresponding page in the book.
	Optional: Highlight the vocabulary words that appear in the book.
	Before reading the book, review the words with the child and put the word cards where the child can see them during the book reading.
	Read the book.
	Stop and ask questions at the designated question pages (when you get to a sticky note).
	During reading, discuss the target vocabulary words and refer to the vocabulary picture cards. During discussion, use conversation strategies.
	Remember to keep the focus on the book reading.
